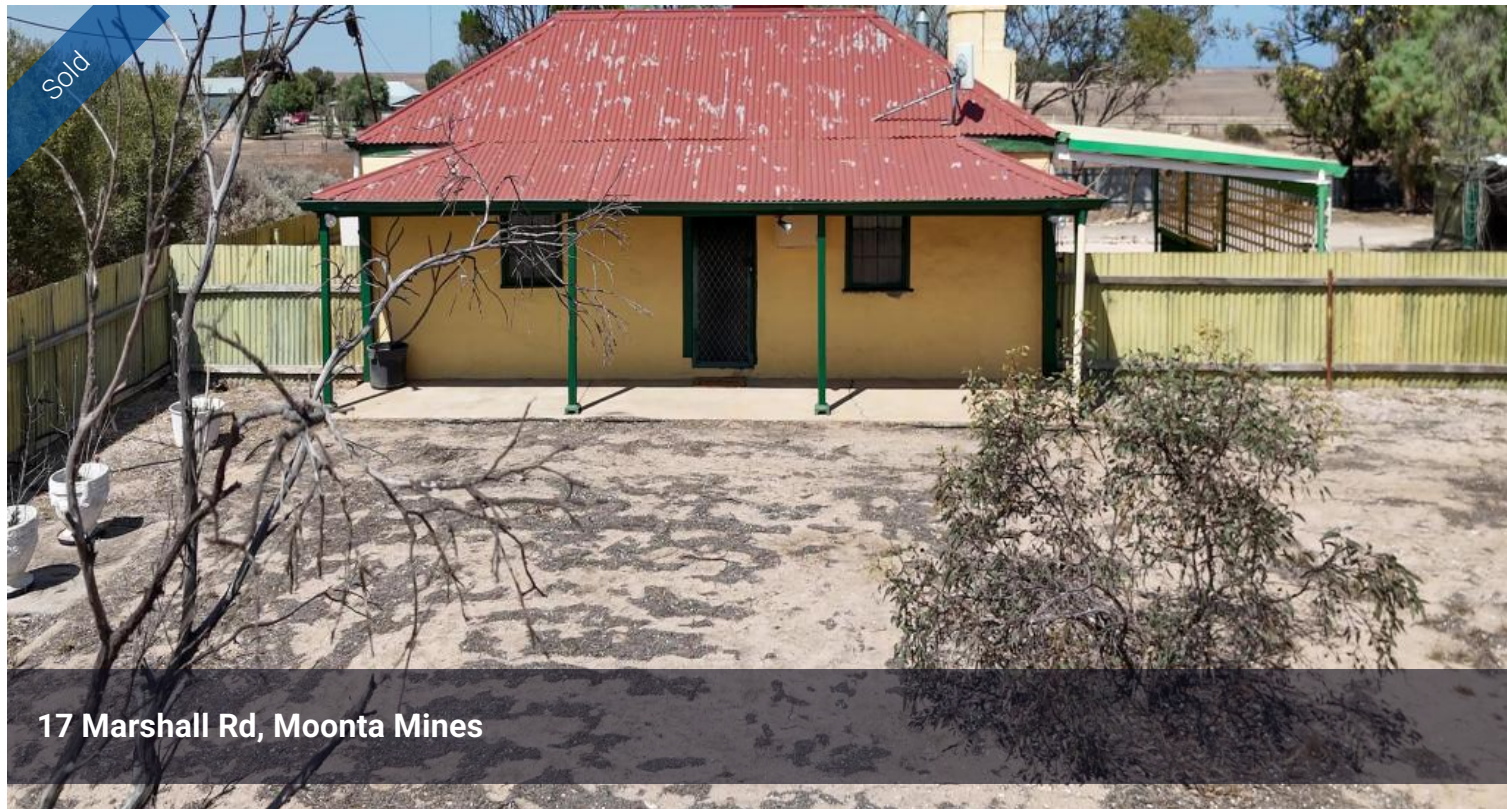

Inside, you'll find three carpeted bedrooms, with the master featuring wall-to-wall built-in cupboards and a ceiling fan. Bedrooms two and three provide ample space for built-in storage. The main living area is warm and inviting, complete with a combustion heater, ceiling fan, and a unique built-in fish tank.

The slate flooring flows into the kitchen, which includes electric cooking appliances and below-bench cupboard space. Adjacent to the kitchen, the dining area boasts floating floorboards and a charming cast iron potbelly stove. The bathroom is well-appointed with a spa bath, shower, vanity unit, and a separate toilet, enhanced by decorative frieze-style tiles that add a touch of elegance. The laundry is conveniently set within an open mudroom. Outside, the property is well-equipped for animal lovers, featuring horse stables, dog kennels, and shedding. Two 22,500-litre rainwater tanks are plumbed to the house, sitting behind the shedding, which is flanked by two single carports. Situated on a rise, the home offers scenic views over the front and rear paddocks, which could be used for cropping or easily converted into small yards.
