Outside, the property includes a concrete wash bay, open yard space, and secure fencing, making it ideal for a variety of commercial or trade-based operations.

Adding to its character is the remnant stone church building — a nod to Quorn's early history — now in need of repair but offering scope for creative restoration or incorporation into future plans (subject to consent).
