Set on approximately 10.7 acres (4.34 hectares)* and elevated to capture sweeping hilltop vistas, this substantial 100-year-old* gentleman's bungalow overlooks the picturesque surrounds of the historic Undalya township and offers classic views across the beautiful Clare Valley.

Constructed from solid brick and rich in heritage features, the home boasts five spacious bedrooms, two of which have fireplaces and three of which have French doors to the outside. Original open fireplaces throughout the home add warmth and atmosphere, while a grand ballroom or formal dining room with a charming bay window seat and double Cedar doors provides an impressive space for entertaining. A wide entrance hallway welcomes you inside, leading to a generous lounge room highlighted by a striking brick fireplace. Jarrah timber flooring flows throughout the home, complemented by distinctive timber bulkhead ceilings and evaporative ducted air conditioning for year-round comfort.

The heart of the home is the modern kitchen and dining area, thoughtfully designed with wraparound cabinetry, a large walk-in pantry, and a cellar

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perfect for storing the region's renowned Clare Valley wines. A 900mm* gas stove, gas oven & wood fired oven cater beautifully to family living and entertaining, while a combustion heater creates a warm and inviting space during the cooler months.

Two generous, fully renovated bathrooms provide modern luxury while maintaining the home's character. One features a truly unique handcrafted Tasmanian oak bath and timber vanity top, creating a stunning focal point. Both bathrooms include underfloor heating and spacious single showers, adding comfort and practicality. The home also offers a functional laundry, a study nook ideal for working from home, and a convenient third toilet located within the courtyard area.

Outdoor living is just as appealing, with front and side verandas providing perfect spaces to relax, entertain, and take in the breathtaking rural views. The property itself is well equipped with a workshop, multiple storage sheds, and an old shearing shed that reflects the area's rural heritage. There is also exciting potential to renovate an existing outbuilding into a one-bedroom retreat or guest accommodation.

Serviced by mains water and supported by a substantial 13.5kW* solar system, the property blends country lifestyle with practical modern infrastructure.
