Come and experience this unique property bordering one of South Australia's most magical national parks, Newland Head Conservation Park.

81.38 ha (approximately 201 acres) and only a few kilometres, or a stroll through the national park, to South Australia's remarkable red-sand beach. Waitpinga Beach is famous for its sand, surfing, fishing, bird watching, rock climbing and crystal-clear waters. For hiking lovers, the property also adjoins the southernmost portion of the Heysen walking trail, the Wild South Coast Way, one of the most memorable portions of the trail that includes the Waitpinga Cliffs.

'Waitpinga Park' is only 10kms (approx) from the city of Victor Harbor. 75km (approximately 90 minutes) from Adelaide's CBD, the picturesque drive to Waitpinga winds through the world-renowned McLaren Vale wine region. The drive is set to become even quicker once the South Road upgrade is complete.

The property is sprinkled with spectacular gum trees, and the higher reaches of the property enjoy stunning rural and coastal views. On a still day, you can hear the crashing waves of Waitpinga Beach.

The property boasts five dams, plus a stock and domestic bore, providing ample good quality water for a grazing enterprise. The property also features three functional sheds, with the largest containing 'three phase power' and was originally used as a calf rearing shed. There is also an approved and mature commercial wood lot.

There is the potential to agist the land, take advantage of the stunning views and wildlife throughout and erect 'tiny houses' or a tourism enterprise (STCA), build your dream home or exclusive getaway (STCA), or even create a B&B with the original cottage (STCA) whilst living in the main residence.
